On November 7th, the School Board finalized and voted to approve the levies renewal package for the February 12, 2013 ballot.

This is an exciting and crucial time for Seattle Public Schools. More families are choosing to raise their families in Seattle and send their children to Seattle Public Schools. With student population expected to grow for the next ten years, renewal of the Capital Levy will address capacity needs and fund safe, quality learning environments for children throughout the city. Renewal of the Operating Levy will fund 27% of Seattle Public Schools' budget for basic day-to-day needs including teaching and instructional programs, sixth period in high school, textbooks, classroom supplies, student activities, and much more.
