Citizens for Pullman Schools Kicks Off Bond Campaign

On Monday, December 17th, 2012, the Citizens for Pullman Schools officially kicked off a campaign for the February 12, 2013 school construction bond election. Co-chairs Danielle Kallaher and Lynda Carey have been organizing efforts for several months and will now focus efforts, with the help of a community committee, toward communicating with the community about the goals of the bond and how it will benefit Pullman.

The Bond, which will fund the renovation and construction of Pullman High School and an elementary classroom expansion, will be presented to voters by mail-in ballot. Ballots will be sent out on January 25 and need to be returned or post-marked by February 12, 2013.

The *Citizens for Pullman Schools* co-chairperson, Danielle Kallaher said, “These projects are important for our kids and for our community. We encourage people to come together to support this important opportunity—*building a future for our kids.*”
