The Court, having considered these submissions and hearing oral argument of the parties, now ORDERS, ADJUDGES, AND DECREES that:

Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment is **GRANTED**. Plaintiffs present a justiciable controversy and have standing to bring this action. RCW 43.135.034(1)'s supermajority vote requirement violates the simple majority provision of Article II, § 22 of the Washington Constitution, rendering that provision of the statute unconstitutional. Further, RCW 43.135.034(2)(a)'s mandatory referendum requirement violates Article II, § 1 and Article II, § 1(b) of the Washington Constitution, rendering that provision of the statute unconstitutional.

Defendant State of Washington's Motion for Summary Judgment and Motions to Strike are **DENIED**.
