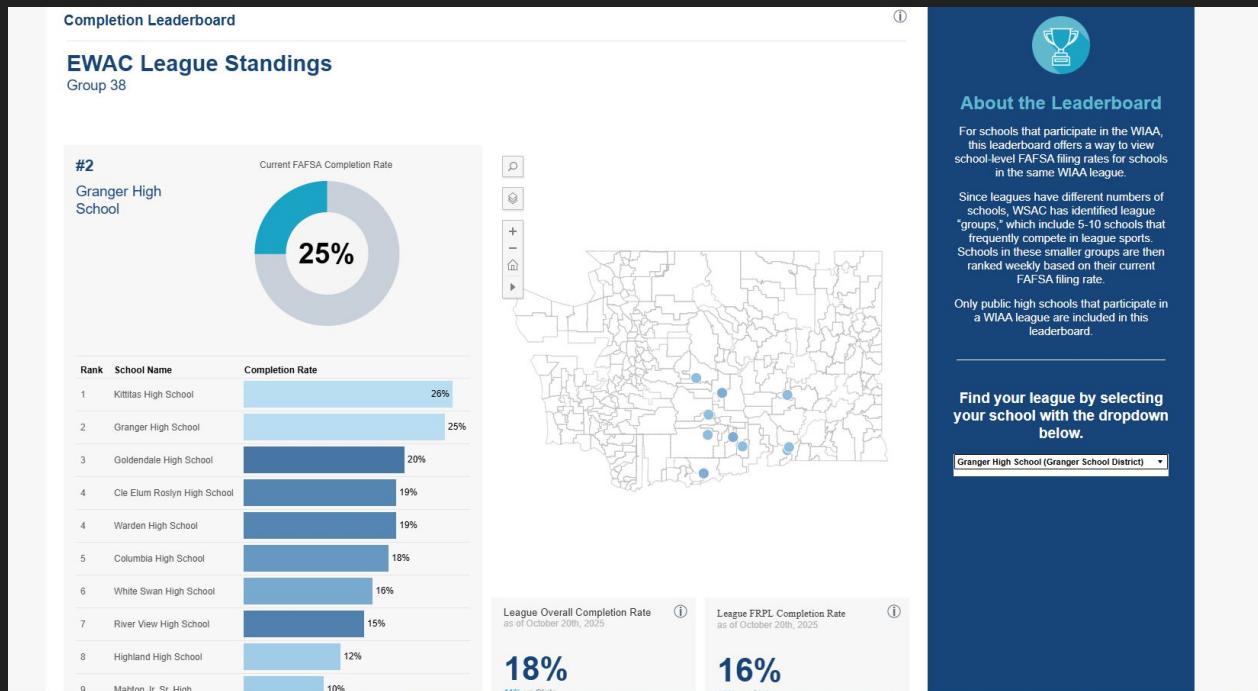

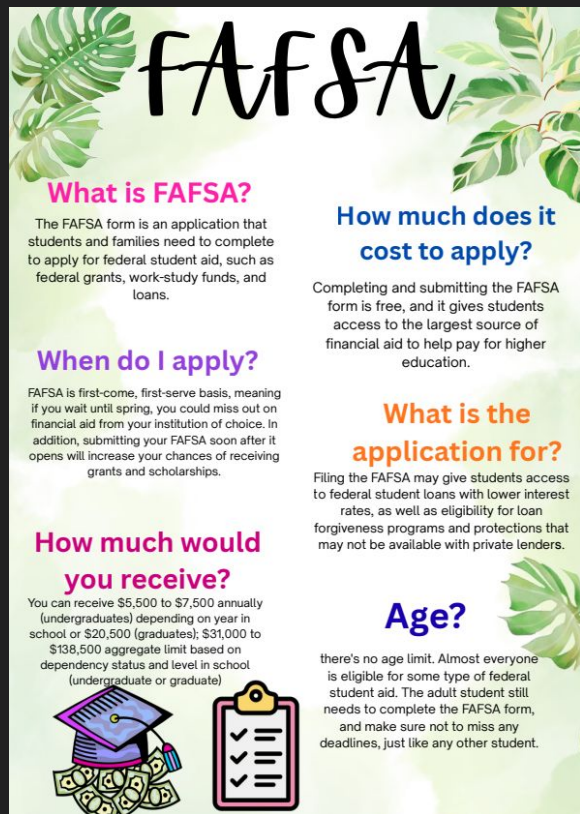

FAFSA

What is FAFSA?

The FAFSA form is an application that students and families need to complete to apply for federal student aid, such as federal grants, work-study funds, and loans.

When do I apply?

FAFSA is first-come, first-serve basis, meaning if you wait until spring, you could miss out on financial aid from your institution of choice. In addition, submitting your FAFSA soon after it opens will increase your chances of receiving grants and scholarships.

How much would you receive?

You can receive \$5,500 to \$7,500 annually (undergraduates) depending on year in school or \$20,500 (graduates); \$31,000 to \$138,500 aggregate limit based on dependency status and level in school (undergraduate or graduate)



How much does it cost to apply?

Completing and submitting the FAFSA form is free, and it gives students access to the largest source of financial aid to help pay for higher education.

What is the application for?

Filing the FAFSA may give students access to federal student loans with lower interest rates, as well as eligibility for loan forgiveness programs and protections that may not be available with private lenders.

Age?

there's no age limit. Almost everyone is eligible for some type of federal student aid. The adult student still needs to complete the FAFSA form, and make sure not to miss any deadlines, just like any other student.

What is FAFSA?

FAFSA is a form students in the U.S. fill out to apply for financial aid to help pay for college or trade school

Why is FAFSA important?

FAFSA is important because it helps you get money for college, like grants and loans, which can make paying for school easier.

What is needed to apply for FAFSA?

- Citizenship status
- Social security number
- Financial information

What is the process for FAFSA?

you collect your money info, like tax papers. Next, you fill out the FAFSA form online. After you send it in, the government checks it and sends you a report that shows how much help you can get. Then, the schools you picked use that report to give you financial aid offers.

WASFA

The Washington Application For State Financial Aid (WASFA) is for people who have chosen to not fill out a FAFSA. People who fill out a WASFA application are only applying for state aid. So be sure to check if you qualify for FAFSA.

Applying for WASFA, even if you don't qualify for FAFSA is crucial as the state will provide financial aid you will need for your education.

NO DEADLINE FOR WASFA! APPLY NOW!

Gather the documents needed to complete the WASFA; your contributors will need the same items:

- Your income information. This includes bank statements, a W-2 or pay stub, and/or a federal income tax return.
- If you filed out a federal tax return, use tax return information from two years before the current year.
- Additional financial information – such as child support statements, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) or welfare information, real estate, stocks or bonds investments, family business, or farm info.
- Your Social Security card or I-797 Form if you have current or expired DACA status (optional).
- If you are a dependent student (most students under 24 years old), you will also need most of the above information for your parent(s).

There are many reasons why some people choose to complete a WASFA instead of a FAFSA:

- You or your parent(s) are undocumented or do not qualify for federal financial aid because of your immigration status.
- Your parent(s) or family member(s) do not wish to file a FAFSA.
- You have privacy concerns about filing a FAFSA.
- You or your parent(s) do not and will not file federal income taxes.
- You have federal loans that are in default.
- You owe a repayment on federal grants.
